***Personal History***

*John Lee BARLOW was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1899 the son of Josiah and Mary Jane BARLOW nee MOSS who were married 19/06/1886 at St. Paul, Astley Bridge.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 48, Eustace Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 12*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 34, Dunstan Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 2*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Telephone Clerk and Train Booker*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Fusiliers at Bolton, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 March 1918 aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
