John Lee BARLOW was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1899 the son of Josiah and Mary Jane BARLOW nee MOSS who were married 19/06/1886 at St. Paul, Astley Bridge.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 48, Eustace Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 In the 1901 census the family were living at 34, Dunstan Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Telephone Clerk and Train Booker

He enlisted in the Royal Fusiliers at Bolton, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 March 1918 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
