***Personal History***

*John Joseph KERRIGAN was born at Manchester, Lancashire on c. 1890 the son of Patrick and Elizabeth KERRIGAN.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 27, Copstick Street, Ancoats, Manchester.. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Boot Repairer.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 1, Back Grey Street, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 11 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Red Bank as a Washer*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 14 July 1915. His last known address was Ancoats, Manchester, Copstick Street. 27 (1911 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 August 1915 aged 26*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
