*David KYNASTON was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1897 the son of Margaret KYNASTON nee Gregory. Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Letter Sorter*

*He was living at Cheethan Hill, Manchester when he enlisted in the Monmouthshire Regiment at Ashton Under Lyne, Lancashire. on 9 May 1916*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 August 1917 aged 21*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
