Personal History

Lot LAWSON was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1887 the son of August and Ann Elizabeth LAWSON nee WOMACK who were married 1880 at Holy Trinity, Hull, Yorkshire. His father died in 1938. His mother died in 1938.

He enlisted in the Grenadier Guards at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 6 November 1915. His last known address was Goole, North Street, Billington Row, 2 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 12 October 1917 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
