Personal History

Emanuel LAYCOCK was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1855.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 17, Kingsway, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 56 with the occupation of Marine Engineer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 28, Gordon Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 45 with the occupation of Marine Engineer.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Annie Elizabeth LAYCOCK (nee SMITH) They married at Bradford, Yorkshire on 25 February 1905. They had children: Alfred b. 1883, Annie b. 1885, Francis b. 1893, Ethel b. 1899

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company
