Personal History

Frank BARNES was born at Blackley, Manchester, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Elijah and Alice BARNES nee ROYLE who were married 1881 at St. Peter, Blackley, Manchester, Lancashire. His father died in 1961. His mother died in 1961.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 60, York Terrace, Pew Road, Blackley, Manchester,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Marker Off.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 61 Waterloo Street, Crumpsall, Manchester,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Newton Heath as a Cleaner

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancasters at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 2 March 1916 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
