Andrew LEDDY was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Patricj and Catherine LEDDY nee MYLES who were married 1884 at Canterbury. His father died in 1909. His mother died in 1909. In the 1911 census the family were living at 194, Boundry Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Booking Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 21, Walmsley Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 24 February 1919 in 33rd Casualty Clearing Stn. France aged 24 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
