Personal History

Edward LEDSON was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1899 the son of Henry and Catherine LEDSON nee SMITH who were married 25/06/1896 at St. Peter, Aintree, Liverpool. His father died in 1949. His mother died in 1949.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 21, Rugby Road, Liverpool,. He was aged 11

In the 1901 census the family were living at 17, Ealing Road, Liverpool,. He was aged 1

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Indicator Youth

He was living at Bootle, Liverpool when he enlisted in the Royal Fusiliers (London Regiment) at Waterloo.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 24 April 1918

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
