## Personal History

John William LEE was born at Machester, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Richard Thomas and Ellen Loisa LEE nee AUSTIN who were married 1892 at St. Clements, Broughton, Salford. His father died in 1952. His mother died in 1952.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 96, Gakell Street, Newton Heath, Manchester,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Cotton Mill Piecer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 26, Alexandra Street, Broughton, Salford,. He was aged 7
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon
Dept. at Newton Heath as a Labourer

## Service History

He was living at Newton Heath when he enlisted in the Scottish Borderers Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 18 July 1915. His last known address was Newton Heath, Manchester, Gaskell Street, 96 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 7 September 1915 in Gallipoli aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
