Percy LEE was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1890 the son of Levi and Sarah Ellen LEE nee WEARDEN who were married 21/07/1888 at St. James The Apostle, Bolton. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 18, Latham Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Cotton Mill Piecer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 13, Egerton Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at 15, Egerton Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 months Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bolton, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 August 1918 aged 28 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
