Richard Henry LEE was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1894 the son of Richard Henry and Christina LEE nee MARSDEN. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, Coventry Strteet, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Mill Jobber.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Bradford as an Extra Cater

He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 July 1916 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
