***Personal History***

*George LEECH was born at Gorton, Manchester.*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Newton Heath as a Labourer*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers. and embarked for Balkans on 2 June 1915. His last known address was Miles Platting, Manchester, Varley Street, 41 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 June 1915 in Gallipoli*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
