Personal History

Walter Wilson BARNISH was born at Preston, Lancashire in 1891 the son of James Wilson and Clara BARNISH nee MEREDITH who were married 1883 at Nantwich Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1928. His mother died in 1928.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 4, Wellfield Road, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of A Rubber Worker at a Tyre Works.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 49, Hamilton Road, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 9
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon

He was living at Preston, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at the same place. on 29 May 1915

He is recorded as Killed in action on 8 August 1916 aged 25
