In the 1911 census the family were living at 57, London Terrace, Darwen, Lancashire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Cotton Weavers Drawer In.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 34, Tythe Barn Street, Darwn, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Extra Porter

He enlisted in the Kings Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Darwen, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 26 September 1917 aged 24
