William John LITTLE was born at St. Helens, Lancashire in 1893 the son of William and Lavinia LITTLE. Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Walton Junction as a Platelayer

Service History

He enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment. and embarked for France on 16 March 1915. He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 1 July 1916 aged 23 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
