Personal History

Robert Harrison LLOYD was born at Goole, Yorkshire on 29 August 1885 the son of John Joseph and Harriet LLOYD nee HARRISON who were married 1895 at Goole, Yorkshire. His father died in 1942. His mother died in 1942.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 4, Couper Street, Old Goole, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Checker at Docks.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 4, Back Couper Street, Old Goole, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 26 August 1915. His last known address was Goole, Southon Street, 3 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 July 1916 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
