***Personal History***

*William John LOGAN was born at Newton Heath, Manchester in 1896 the son of Joseph and Ada Unsworth LOGAN nee COOPE who were married 26/12/1890 at St. Mary, Prestwich. His father died in 1948. His mother died in 1948.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 327, Droylsden Road, Newton Heath, Manchester,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Stn Booking Clerk.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 327, Droylsden Road, Newton Heath, Manchester,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line at Hollinwood as a Clerk*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 10 November 1915. His last known address was Newton Heath, Manchester, Richmond Street, 37 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 29 August 1916 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
