## Personal History

William John LOGAN was born at Newton Hearth, Manchester in 1896 the son of Joseph and Ada Unsworth LOGAN nee COOPE who were married 26/12/1890 at St. Mary, Prestwich. His father died in 1948. His mother died in 1948.

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 10 November 1915. His last known address was Newton Heath, Manchester, Richmond Street, 37 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 29 August 1916 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
