Personal History

James Douglas LYON was born at Huddersfield, Yprkshire in 1888 the son of John and Deborah LYON nee ANDREW who were married 1886 at St. Matthew. Stockport, .

In the 1911 census the family were living at The Ridings, Huddesfield Road, Birstall, Yorkshire,. He was aged 23 with the occupation of Mech. Eng. Locomotive Design.

In the 1901 census the family were living at The Ridings, Huddersfield Road Birstall, Yorkshire,. He was aged 13

In the 1891 census the family were living at Hollins House, Marsden, Nr. Huddersfield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Newton Heath as a Fitter

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 11 February 1919 aged 32

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
