Personal History

Arthur LYONS was born at Wigan, Lancashire in 1887 the son of Martin and Eliza Jane LYONS nee HENRY who were married 1878 at Wigan Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at India, 1st Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Private.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 1, Church Terrace, Wigan, Lancashire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of General Errand Boy.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 40, Wellington Street, Wigan, Lancashire,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Wigan as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Wigan, Lancashire. and embarked for - France on 22 August 1914. His last known address was India, 1st Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers, Age 24, Private

He is recorded as Killed in action on 26 August 1914 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
