Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bury as a Cleaner*

**Service History**

*He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 14 September 1915. His last known address was Bury, Fishpool, Horne Street, 7 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died on 22 October 1915 in Murdos aged 18*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
