Personal History

Hugh McCOLL was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1899 the son of Archibald and Mary McCOLL nee COLFORD who were married 1890 at Liverpool Register Office or Registrar Attended.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 23, Howley Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 12

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Good'd Manager's Dept., at Liverpool, Great Howard as a Porter*

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Liverpool. Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 15 July 1916 in Militay Hospital, Orpington, Kent aged 17

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
