Thomas McCONNON was born at Meath Slane, Ireland in 1896 the son of Bernard and Bridget McCONNON. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 17, Whitely Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Joiner at School.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Ostler

He was living at Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment at the same place. He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 1 October 1918 aged 22
