*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Ostler*

*He was living at Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment at the same place.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 1 October 1918 aged 22*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
