Personal History

Robert Henry McDONALD was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Robert and Martha Ann McDONALD nee TETLOW who were married 05/08/1893 at St. Georges, Manchester.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 56, Limes Street, Newton, Manchester,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Sheet Maker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 1, Hibberts Place, Manchester,. He was aged 6

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary Alice McDONALD (nee MURRAY) They married at St. Barnabas, Oldham Road, Manchester on 29 March 1905. They had children: Robert H. b. 1916

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Sheet Repairer

He enlisted in the Machine Gun Corps at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 13 April 1918 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
