***Personal History***

*Thomas McEVOY was born at Liverpool, Lancashire on 29 January 1895 the son of Robert and Margaret McEVOY nee MADDEN who were married 13/07/1891 at St. Peter, Liverpool. His father died in 1934. His mother died in 1934.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 29, Pembroke Street, Liverpool. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Bolter.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 73, Gill Street, Liverpool,. He was aged 6*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Hotel and Refreshment Rooms at Liverpool as a Cellarman*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the South Lancashire Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 1 July 1915. His last known address was Liverpool, Pembroke Street, 29 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 29 May 1918 aged 23*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
