Personal History

Rowland McFARLAND was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1889 the son of Frederick and Alice Ann McFARLAND nee HEALD who were married 29/04/1883 at St. Philip, Hulme, Manchester. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, York Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Carter, General Carter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 30, Lythan Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 12

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 18, Sand Street, Ordsall, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 2
He was a married man. His wife's name was Angelina McFARLAND (nee HUGHES) They married at Christ Church, Salford, Lancashire on 3 August 1912. They had children: Rowland Frederick b. 1913, Angelina b. 1815*

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Salford as a Carter

Service History

He was living at Salford, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 5 July 1915. His last known address was Salford, York Street, 3 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 17 September 1916 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
