Personal History

Henry McLINDEN was born at Walton on the Hill, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Patrick and Agnes McLINDEN nee SPENCER who were married 1889 at St. Peter, Liverpool. His father died in 1940. His mother died in 1940.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 26, Loxham Street, Great Lever, Bolton,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 16, Harper Road, Walton on the Hill, Liverpool,. He was aged 8 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Bolton D.G.S.O. as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at Great Lever, Bolton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 8 November 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Moncrefte Street, 20 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 23 April 1917 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
