***Personal History***

*George Edward Wilcock BARRETT was born at Halifax, Yorkshire in 1894 the son of William and Mary Lily BARRETT nee WILCOCK who were married 07/09/1895 at St. James, Halifax, Yorkshire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 4, York Street, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Stableman.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 13, Beech Hill Terrace, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 6 He was a married man. His wife's name was Lillian BARRETT (nee DANETRY)*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Vanman*

***Service History***

*He was living at Halifax, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at the same place.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 26 October 1917 in 11th General Hospital aged 23*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
