Personal History

Arcibald McMILLAN was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1883 the son of Archibald and Margaret McMILLAN. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Boyd Street, Everton. Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 26 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 17. New Hedley Street, Liverpool,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Printers Finisher.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary E. McMILLAN (nee DWERRYHOUSE) They married at St. Ambrose, Everton, Liverpool on 19 April 1902. They had children: Archibald b. 1903, Elizabeth b. 1905, Arthur b. 1908, Robert b. 1908

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Liverpool North as a Sheeter

Service History

He was living at Everton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 12 August 1914. His last known address was Liverpool, Everton. Daniel Street, 9 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 31 October 1914 aged 31

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & Clasp
