Personal History

Michael McNULTY was born at Stackshead, Lancashire in 1882 the son of Michael and Mary McNULTY nee FITZPATRICK who were married 18/02/1879 at Hyburn Register Office or Registrar Attended.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 386, Newchurch Road, Bacup, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Stone Cutter.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 23, Back Tunstead Terrace, Bacup, Lancashire,. He was aged 9 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Rochdale as a Checker

Service History

He was living at Rochdale, Lancashire when he enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Bacup, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 22 August 1914. His last known address was Bacup, Newchurch Road, 386 (1901 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 August 1918 aged 36

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star and Clasp
