Ernest McTRUSTY was born at Colne, Lancashire in 1896 the son of James and Elizabeth McTRUSTY nee MARTIN who were married 1879 at Alendale, Cumbria. His father died in 1927. His mother died in 1927. In the 1911 census the family were living at 179, Whalley Range, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Railway Train Booker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 105, Anvil Street, Blackburn,. He was aged 4
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

He was living at Blackburn, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment at the same place. He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 March 1918 aged 22 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
