## Personal History

Arthur MADDY was born at Ancoats, Manchester, Lancashire on 13 September 1894 the son of Edwin Whitcombe and Mary MADDY nee CORBETT who were married 1886 at Worcester, Worcestershire. His father died in 1938. His mother died in 1938.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, Arnold Street, Rochdale Road, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Hancock Street, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 6
He was a married man. His wife's name was Agnes MADDY (nee MCNIECE) They married at Manchester

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. on 3 September 1914 and embarked for France on 25 September 1916. His last known address was Manchester, Rochdale Road, Susan Street, 12 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 June 1917 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
