Personal History

Michael MADIGAN was born at Preston, Lancashire in 1877 the son of Michael and Catherine MADIGAN.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 74, Bedford Street, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 34 with the occupation of Cotton Spinner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 14, Alburn Street, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Cotton Spinner.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 61, Spring Garden, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Cotton Throstle Room Hand.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Annie MADIGAN (nee JENKINSON) They married at Preston Register Office or Registrar Attended on 20 March 1905. They had children: Margaret b.1906, William b. 1910, Annie b. 1913

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Preston as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 25 September 1915. His last known address was Preston, Bedford Street, 74 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 May 1916 aged 39

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
