Personal History

John MAGUIRE was born at Kirkham, Lancashire in 1883 the son of John and Isabella MAGUIRE nee STOCKDALE who were married 1872 at Holy Trinity, Toxteth Park, Liverpool, Lancashire . His mother died in 1929.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 52, Station Road. Kirkham, Lancashire,. He was aged 28 with the occupation of Railway Platelayer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 10. Barnfield, Kirkham, Lancashire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Apprentice Blacksmith.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 10. Barnfield, Kirkham, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Sarah MAGUIRE (nee ASTON) They married at Oldham Register Office or Registrar Attended on 22 March 1905. They had children: Harold b. 1910, Charlotte b.1911, John Robert b. 1914

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Kirkham as a Chagemans Labourer

Service History

He was living at Kirkham, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Lytham, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Kirkham, Station Road, 52 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 June 1915 aged 32

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
