



***Private Clifford Wade BARROW***

*1544 1st Battalion Royal Irish Rifles*

*Killed in action 9 May 1915 aged 22*

*Commemorated Ploegsteert Memorial, Belgium Panel 9*

***Personal History***

*Clifford Wade BARROW was born at Kirkdale, Liverpool in 1893 the son of Thomas and Charlotte Ann BARROW nee RAVEN who were married 1886 at Wakefield, Yorkshire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 65, Brierlley Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Cotton Spinner.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 104, Nelson Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 8*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bury as a Cleaner*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Irish Rifles at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 20 March 1915. His last known address was Bury, Elton, Buller Street, 12 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 May 1915 aged 22*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
