## Personal History

Clifford Wade BARROW was born at Kirkdale, Liverpool in 1893 the son of Thomas and Charlotte Ann BARROW nee RAVEN who were married 1886 at Wakefield, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 65, Brierlley Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Cotton Spinner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 104, Nelson Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 8
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at
Bury as a Cleaner

## Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Irish Rifles at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 20 March 1915. His last known address was Bury, Elton, Buller Street, 12 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 May 1915 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
