## Personal History

Herbert MARRITT was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1887 the son of George Rands and Martha Ann MARRITT nee HALLIDAY who were married 1865 at Stockto, Durham. His father died in 1925. His mother died in 1925.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 6, Swan Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 16, Wesley Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14
In the 1891 census the family were living at 26, Wesley Square, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 4
He was a married man. His wife's name was Edith MARRITT (nee JACKSON) They married at Goole,
Yorkshire on 4 June 1908. They had children: Eliza Ann b.1908 (Stepdaughter)
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Goole Steam Shipping
at Goole as a Labourer

## Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 March 1917 aged 30 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
