*8th Battalion Manchester Regiment*

*Killed in action 4 June 1915 aged 23*

***Personal History***

*Reginald MARSDEN was born at Scarborough, Yorkshire in 1892 the son of George William and Jesse Gertrude MARSDEN nee CURTIS who were married 1891 at Scarborough, Yorkshire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 63, Esmond Road, Cheetham Hill, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged Railway Servant*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 25, Sycamore Road, Birkenhead, Lancashire,. He was aged 9 He was a married man. His wife's name was Ida Maud MARSDEN (nee SPENCER) They married at St. Paul, Nicosia, Cyprus on 12 January 1915*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Salford as a Sub Agent*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 June 1915 in Dardanelles aged 23*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
