***Personal History***

*Thomas MARSDEN was born at Southport, Lancashire in 1893 the son of William and Mary MARSDEN nee SQUIRES who were married 16/09/1886 at St. Paul, Southport, Lancashire. His father died in 1896. His mother died in 1896.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at Blackmoss Lane, Scarisbrick, Lancashire. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Farm Labourer.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 27, Warwick Street, Southport, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 He was a married man. His wife's name was Ellen MARSDEN (nee CHURCH) They married at St. Mark, Scarisbrick, Ormskirk, Lancashire on 29 March 1905. They had children: Edith E. b.1915*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Southport as a Washer*

***Service History***

*He was living at Scarisbrick, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Southport, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 August 1917 aged 23*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
