Thomas Percival MARSDEN was born at Blackpool, Lancashire in 1896 the son of John and Margaret MARSDEN nee MARSDEN.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 22, Woodfield Road, Crumpsall, Manchester, Lancs,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Pattern Card Maker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 3, David Street, Manchester,. He was aged 5
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the
Lines Dept. at Manch. (Letter Despatch) as a Messenger

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Salford, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died on 9 January 1917 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
