Personal History

Cyril Cecil Stanley BARROW was born at Hull, Yorkshire in 1894 the son of Richard A. and Caroline BARROW nee DESFORGES who were married 1883 at Louth, Lincolnshire. His father died in 1958. His mother died in 1958.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 96, Blundell Avenue, Cleethorpes, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Milk Assistant.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 104, Blundell Street, Cleethorpes, Lancashire,. He was aged 7 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Fitters Labourer

He enlisted in the Dragoon Guards at Hull, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 24 March 1918 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
