In the 1901 census the family were living at 33, St. John Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 1 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Timetaker

He enlisted in the Cheshire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 October 1918 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
