Personal History

James Edward MARSHALL was born at Scarisbrick, Lancashire in 1890 the son of John and Ann MARSHALL nee LEATHERBARROW who were married 29/11/1890 at St Mark. Scarisbrick, Ormstirk, Lancashire. His father died in 1896. His mother died in 1896.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Damwood Lane, Scarisbrick, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Bescar, Scarisbrick, Lancashire,. He was aged 10

In the 1891 census the family were living at Bescar, Scarisbrick, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 months

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Southport as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 23 October 1914. His last known address was Scarisbrick, Lancashire (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of tuberculosis on 21 February 1919 in Home aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
