Personal History

Albert George Glover MASKELL was born at Britlingsea, Essex on 1971? the son of George and Matilda Victoria MASKELL nee CANTALL who were married 1867 at Lexden, Essex. His mother died in 1893. In the 1911 census the family were living at 64, Harris Streetm Fleetwood,. He was aged 39 with the occupation of Railway Marine Engineer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 64, Harris Streetm Fleetwood,. He was aged 29 with the occupation of Marine Engineer.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 7, St Peter's Place, Thorton, Fleetwood, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Locomotive Fitter.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Rachel Agnes MASKELL (nee GORNALL) They married at Fylde, Lancashire on 13 March 1905. They had children: Irene Victoria b. 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a 2nd Engineer

He enlisted in the Royal Naval Reserve.

He is recorded as Died on 24 August 1916 aged 45
