Personal History

Richard MAWDSLEY was born at Formby, Lancashire in 1889 the son of Joseph and Catherine MAWDSLEY nee BUTLER who were married 1888 at Ormskirk Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1965.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, Chapel Lane, Formby, Lancashire,. He was aged 21. No Trade In the 1901 census the family were living at Hassall Lane, Formby, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1891 census the family were living at Duke Street, Formby, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 months Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Formby as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at Formby, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place. and embarked for France on 7 March 1915. His last known address was Formby, Liverpool, Chapel Lane, 3 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 September 1917 aged 28 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
