***Personal History***

*Richard MAWDSLEY was born at Formby, Lancashire in 1889 the son of Joseph and Catherine MAWDSLEY nee BUTLER who were married 1888 at Ormskirk Register Office or Registrar Attended . His mother died in 1965.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, Chapel Lane, Formby, Lancashire,. He was aged 21. No Trade*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at Hassall Lane, Formby, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 with the occupation of Scholar.*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at Duke Street, Formby, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 months*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Formby as a Labourer*

***Service History***

*He was living at Formby, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place. and embarked for France on 7 March 1915. His last known address was Formby, Liverpool, Chapel Lane, 3 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 September 1917 aged 28*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
