Albert George MAYSON was born at Whithaven, Cumberland on 26 March 1891 the son of George and Margaret Jane MAYSON nee MAHONE who were married 1877 at Whitehaven, Cumberland. In the 1911 census the family were living at 11, Delhi Street, Swansea, Wales,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Fisherman.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 29, Albert Stree, Fleetwood, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 He was a married man. His wife's name was Bessie Rebecca MAYSON (nee BIRKETT) They married at Old Fylde Register Office or Registrar Attended on 26 March 1905. They had children: Albert b.1913, Albert b. 1914

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Marine Dept. West Coast at Fleetwood as a Seaman

He enlisted in the Royal Naval Reserve.

He is recorded as Died on 18 March 1915 aged 24
