Personal History

Joseph Vincent BARRY was born at Sheffield, Yorkshire in 1885 the son of Thomas and Sarah Jane BARRY who were married 1882 at Wincanton, Somerset.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Churchill Street, Upper Wortley Road, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 25 with the occupation of Railway Capstanman.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 7, Lisbon Street, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Delivery Boy.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 11, Sand Street, Manchester,. He was aged 5

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary Barry BARRY (nee PINDER) They married at Chridt Church, Leeds on 18 September 1915. They had children: Eva Mary b. 1910, Muriel b.1911, Lilian b. 1913, Mary B. b.1919?

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept,. at Leeds as a Capstanman

Service History

He enlisted in the West Yorkshire Regiment at Leeds, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 15 August 1915. His last known address was Leeds, Upper Wortley Road, Churchill Street, 2 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 11 October 1918 aged 33

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
